



COVID UPDATE 2022-02-28

Dear Harmony Families,

Today, Governor Newsom released a time schedule for changes to indoor masking requirements for schools. As of March 12th, masking “requirements” will be replaced with “recommendations”. School Districts and local public health departments will be responsible for setting guidelines on indoor masking (and other mitigations) based on these recommendations. Important to this process will be understanding how changes to indoor masking impact quarantine requirements.

Harmony Union School District will continue to employ appropriate standards that mitigate the risks presented by different intensities of the COVID endemic / epidemic, while keeping the school open and as least restrictive as possible.

We await further information on mitigation recommendations and quarantine requirements from the CDPH and our County Public Health Department. Once received, we will develop revised protocols that continue to protect the health and well-being of our children, staff and community. A community forum will be held shortly thereafter to review the proposed revisions and prepare for implementation of the revised safety plan.

Thank you for your patience as we work through this new information, and for working together for the health and well-being of our community.
